ANNOUNCEMENT: The Department of Contracts and Grants is proud to announce that the C&G Curriculum will be going live with online classes starting **Monday, February 17th, 2014.**

Over the last four years, the Department of Contracts and Grants has offered a [Certificate in Research Administration](#) to all university employees whose responsibilities brought them in contact with any aspect of contracts and grants. This certification previously required students to attend classes in-person, at set times, in various settings across campus. After a careful assessment of student feedback, we have updated all C&G Curriculum courses and transferred them to an online format through [Trojan Learn](#). Instructional courses have been re-designed to foster an interactive learning environment that puts the student in the driver's seat. Some of the highlights of this online system include:

- **Self-Paced Learning:** You can start and exit a course at any time, returning from where you left off upon logging back in.
- **Quizzing:** Quizzes are built into each course so you no longer need to navigate to a separate website in order to take a quiz.
- **24/7 Course Availability:** Take your course at work, at home, at the airport, or anywhere else for that matter. As long as you have a PC/Laptop with a stable internet connection, you can take a course.
- **Interaction:** Students will be required to interact with case studies, scenarios, links, and downloadable files. We also offer the ability to ask questions anytime throughout a course via an interactive button on each slide.
