Announcement: As a reminder, the [Research Performance Progress Report](#) (RPPR) is currently required for all type 5 progress reports submitted using a Streamlined Non-Competing Award Process (SNAP), and will be required for all non-SNAP progress reports submitted on/after October 17, 2014.

For Annual Progress Reports using the RPPR, grantees will need to include a section on how Individual Development Plans (IDPs) are being used to “identify and promote the career goals of graduate students and postdoctoral researchers associated with the award.” Actual IDPs should not be included. For more information, please see [NOT-OD-14-113](#).

Additionally, graduate and undergraduate students working on grants must obtain a Commons ID in order to be included in progress reports (as of October 1st, 2014). Without this information, the RPPR will retrieve an error and will not be accepted. For more information, please see [NOT-OD-13-097](#).
