

NewsFlash!

Please be advised of a KCS2S issue involving the SF424 RR Federal Identifier, field 4.a.

Under very limited circumstances, the value in field 4.a. *can be wiped out by accident*. Due to the nature of the issue, we believe this will primarily impact those submitting DoD / CDMRP proposals.

The Problem

The Federal Identifier (field 4.a.) will be removed by accident if all of the following are true:

1. SF424 RR field 4.a. Federal Identifier = not blank
2. SF424 RR field 8. Type of Application = New
3. User navigates from the SF424 RR page directly to the Summary page. This is the action that clears the Federal Identifier.

The Workaround

Navigating to the Summary page is the action that clears the value in field 4.a. If you ensure the value in the Federal Identifier field is intact and do not access the Summary page after confirming, the value will be transmitted to Grants.gov as expected.

What Cayuse is Doing
